

ADVANTAGE CARD

Sencio Community Leisure is committed to providing accessible and affordable sports and leisure opportunities for everyone. Advantage cardholders are able to **make savings of up to 50% on a range of off-peak weekday activities**. Advantage cardholders are also entitled to card holder rates during peak times.

Advantage is designed to meet the needs of the unwaged, single parent families receiving benefit, people with disabilities, students aged 16+ in full time education, senior citizens (60+) and those recovering from illness or injury. The scheme also covers those receiving income support or housing benefit.

Children (under 16) are not eligible for Advantage. However, children of Advantage cardholders are also eligible for discounts when accompanied and participating with the cardholder. Those eligible to take Advantage simply need to produce one of the forms of identification listed for eligibility at their local participating **Sencio** centre.

Advantage card terms and conditions

Advantage members must agree to abide by the conditions of the scheme and those of the individual centre.

Dry side activity concessions apply only when playing with another Advantage cardholder.

The Advantage card can be used to book in advance for dry side activities, but if you make a booking for a peak time activity, Sencio Card rates will apply.

Advantage concessions do not apply to special sessions and courses.

The Advantage card must be shown when claiming all concessions and must be produced whenever requested by centre personnel.

The Advantage card is valid for Twelve or Six months from the date of issue or until eligibility ceases. (Proof of eligibility required)

Sencio Community Leisure and Sevenoaks District Council reserves the right to cancel or amend any part of its published information and to vary the terms and conditions of the Advantage scheme.

Terms and conditions of use: These terms and conditions shall apply to all card holders using Sencio centres.

Identification: All Advantage Card Holders are required to present an up-to-date Membership card when paying for activities at any Sencio Community Leisure Centres in order to qualify for reduced rates entitled by their card.

Suitable footwear and clothing must be worn at all times appropriate to the permitted activity as advised by Centre staff.

The following are not permitted in the Centre: i) Smoking ii) The bringing of alcohol and its consumption in the Centre iii) The taking or carrying of illegal drugs iv) The use of photographic equipment without written permission from the Manager.

Admissions: The Manager may refuse the admission of any person and may similarly require any person to leave the Centre at any time as well as alter the hours of business, programme of events, admission fees and Centre rules from time to time. The Centre Manager reserves the right to exclude any person who does not comply with terms and conditions of use as noted.

Maintenance: It may be necessary to undertake essential maintenance to the facility and its equipment at any time. Every attempt will be made to provide advance notice and to minimise disruption and inconvenience. The Centre Manager reserves the right to offer recompense only in the event of full and prolonged closure at their sole and absolute discretion. Sencio Community Leisure shall not be liable for any default in service or equipment that is unavailable due to breakdown or circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

Personal loss or damage: Personal items that are left in the Centre are left at the Customers' risk and Sencio Community Leisure cannot accept liability for any loss or damage of such belongings. Lockers should be used where available but they do not guarantee that theft or damage will not occur.

Damage to equipment: Customers who break or damage equipment, otherwise than through its proper use, will be liable for the cost of repair or replacement. Customers using the gym or taking part in other high activity exercise are required to use towels to mop up any perspiration they create on the equipment or floor, unless otherwise stated.

Minimum age for unaccompanied children: Children under the age of 8 are not permitted to use any of the pools unless accompanied by a parent or guardian or other responsible person into the water unless they are attending a specialist session.

Cancellation: Cancellation of any booking must be at least 48 hours prior. Failure to honour any booking without giving 48 hours notice may result in the individual being liable for the full charge should we be unable to re-let the facility or activity.

Non-transferable Membership: The Advantage Card and its use are personal to the particular member it is granted to and can not be assigned or otherwise transferred.

Licensing and Safety: Advantage Card holders must at all times adhere to all insurance and licensing regulations relevant to their booking and all Health and Safety regulations including all safety instructions issued by Centre staff.

Improper use of facilities or equipment: Use of individual facilities or apparatus within the Centre is subject to the rules that may apply to the facility or apparatus as may be displayed or imparted by the instructor or Centre staff. Members and card holders are advised to follow these instructions carefully, as Sencio Community Leisure will not accept liability for any injury caused by the incorrect use of a facility or apparatus.
